### ***God's Purposes Need To Be Prayed Over***

In these two passages, there is a common theme: prayer. They were not deceived into thinking that success was automatic. We understand the necessity of prayer in order for the purposes of God to be fulfilled. You can pray at any point during the prayer watch, for any amount of time. You do not have to pray for the entire watch unless the Lord directs you to do so. The goal is to have someone praying for ENC at some point in every prayer watch.

Father, I thank You that You have called me to be a fellow workman and laborer together with You. You have given me spiritual authority over all the works of the enemy. I take my responsibility seriously and declare that I will be faithful in prayer and intercession. I submit myself to You and the authority of Your Word. Jesus said that whatever things I ask of You, as I believe, I will receive them! The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. It changes situations and circumstances and brings the will of Your Kingdom into our church and community.

By faith, I declare that Evangel North Church is a strong body of believers rooted and built up in You. We are established in the faith and abound in thanksgiving. We are spiritually wise and keep our minds set on things above, Kingdom mindsets and Kingdom principles! We are compassionate, kind, humble, meek, and patient. We bear long with one another and forgive one another. Love reigns in our church family! We walk in peace, encouraging each another. Every area of our lives is spiritually in order. We are steadfast in prayer, diligent to study the Word and not easily deceived or caught up in false doctrines. We are discerning and hear Your voice as our Good Shepherd. We speak the

truth in love and are a body that is fitly joined together. Every member is in their right place and healthy in every way. We are faithful, committed, unified, and passionate. The fruit and the gifts of the Spirit flow in our church freely and unhindered. We do not grieve the Spirit of God, but we cultivate an atmosphere where You are welcome!

Father, it is Your Will that we pray for our pastors, spiritual leaders and those who labor among us for the sake of the Gospel. We declare that we will be faithful to pray for our ministers at Evangel North Church. We declare Your blessings over them and their families. We will not allow ourselves to judge or criticize them, but we will intercede for them and undergird them with prayer. We boldly say that no weapon formed against them will prosper, everything they put their hand to is blessed, they are strong in You, LORD, all their needs are met, they hold fast to sound teaching, and there is freedom of utterance in the ministry of the Word. The Spirit of the LORD - the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge rests upon them, and they are anointed and unhindered in fulfilling the duties You have entrusted to them.

(Mark 3; Acts 20; 2 Corinthians 4; Philippians 2:9-10)

In the name of Jesus, we let our light shine in Southern Indiana so that men may see and give glory to You, Father. We share the Gospel with those around us, have favor with all people, and You, LORD, are adding to Evangel North Church daily those who are being saved.
