- Koinonia Power of Partnership continues
- Oct. 2 – receiving partners – public confession of an personal truth

I. Behold – something to stare at, study, Don't fail to inspect: CHANGE YOUR PERSPECTIVE

II. Good & Pleasant –

- Christians used this phrase when connecting Jews & Gentiles
- Good – Brings Profit – there are benefits... its worth your time & effort
- Pleasant – Brings Contentment – true peace of life – like different sounds make harmony

III. Brethren –

- Not natural relatives, but blood partners
- A relationship of calling not carnal, choice not chance

IV. Dwell

- A relationship that stands
- Not easily thrown away, because its your covering

V. Unity

- Jesus – John 17:21
- Mind, Judgment – I Corinthians 1:10
- Heart – Philippians 2:2-4
- Work – II Corinthians 6:1

VI. Precious Oil

- Exodus 30:25, 30 –
- Fragrant, mixed spices – like each of our graces mixed together
- Holy – we are called to live different – not common and like everyone else
- Sanctifying – we are called to fulfill destiny – kings, prophets, priest, sanctuary, and utensils
- Healing – we are called to eliminate disease – spiritual, soulish, physical
- Authority – we are called to walk in dominion – we are thermostats not thermometers

VII. Connected Priest

- Head, beard, skirt
- Abundant – not sprinkled, poured out to overflow
- To the level the skirt is connected to the body of the priest, walks in same anointing
- Your submission to the body determines the authority you walk in the Spirit:
- James 4:7 - Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.
- From the top of head, to the bottom of skirt: remember partaker of blessing: Philippians 1

VIII. Hermon's Dew

- It descends... It happens
- So thick, like it rained all night, even in drought
- Fertilizes, causes land to productive and effective – God glorified when productive –
- John 15:8 - By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.
- Prepares ground to receive seed – Heart ready for Word

IX. Commanded Blessing

- There... the Lord commands His Blessing, not anyplace, but THERE
- I Kings 17:9 - Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and dwell there. See, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you.
- Includes all the blessing or promises:
- I Corinthians 1:20 - For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.
- Commanded Blessing: He speaks and it is done

X. Life Forevermore

- Today and forever
- Psalm 27:13 - I would have lost heart, unless I had believed That I would see the goodness of the LORD In the land of the living.
- Deuteronomy 11:21 - that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth.
- Mark 10:29-30 - So Jesus answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time--houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions--and in the age to come, eternal life.
