



**Prayer Moves God**

[2Sa 21:14 NASB] 14 They buried the bones of Saul and Jonathan his son in the country of Benjamin in Zela, in the grave of Kish his father; thus they did all that the king commanded, and after that God was moved by prayer for the land.

Read receipts on emails. They can be used against you. Don't leave people on "read", it offends them.

How does this have anything to do with prayer and the Holy Spirit?

"God was moved by prayer for the land." (some translations "entreated": not one-way communication but heard and answered. God received the prayer and released the answer. (Gesenius Hebrew Chaldean Lexicon)
