Larry Lea taught that the Jewish Rabbis believed there were seven arteries to the spirit, but never discovered what they were.

Parental, Presence, Priorities, Provision, Pardon, Power, Partnership

Seven spiritual principles to base prayer...1. Recite Prayer, 2. Use as Outline, 3. Understand Principles

Interrogative: What is in The Lord's Prayer that makes it special.

Transitional: There are seven needs that are addressed in The Lord's Prayer.

Parental Need - "Our Father which art in heaven,

• Picture Calvary and thank God, you can call Him our Father by virtue of the blood of Jesus. Identity, Authority, Relationship

This sets the stage to our prayers: our identity, our authority, our relationship.

"Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need." Hebrews 4:16

Presence Need - hallowed be Thy Name..." Mat. 6:9

He dwells where His Name is

I Kings 8:29 - that Your eyes may be open toward this temple night and day, toward the place of which You said, 'My name shall be there,' that You may hear the prayer which Your servant makes toward this place.

Matthew 18:20 - For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.

Sin Yahweh-tsidkenu The Lord my Righteousness (Jer. 23:5-6

& 2 Cor. 5:21)

Yahweh-m'kaddesh The Lord Who Sanctifies (Ex. 31:13

& Heb. 10:10)

Spirit Immanuel The Lord is with us (ls. 7:14 & Matt. 1:23)

Yahweh-shammah The Lord is There (Eze. 48:35 & Heb. 13:5)

Soundness Yahweh-rophe The Lord Who Heals (Ex. 15:26 & Jam. 5:14-15)

Yahweh-shalom The Lord is Peace (Jdg. 6:24 & Phil. 4:7-9)

Success Yahweh-jireh God's Provision Shall Be Seen Gen. 22:13,14 -

Matt. 6:25-34

Security Yahweh-nissi The Lord My Banner (Ex. 17:15 & 2 Cor. 2:14)

Yahweh-rohi The Lord My Shepherd (Ps. 23:1 & Jn. 10)

Salvation Jesus Yahweh is Salvation

Hallow the names of God corresponding with the benefits in the New Covenant and make your faith declarations.

Priority Need - "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven..."

Lay your will aside, Declare His Will (it is declarative)

Areas:

Yourself

Your family (spouse, children, other family members)

Your church (pastor, leadership, faithfulness of the people, harvest, etc.)

Nation (city, state and national political and spiritual leaders, a specific nation)

The nations (pick a nation; pray for Israel daily)

We must give ourselves wholly to the Will of God

Stop waiting for things to just happen and prayerfully command things to change

Expect God to answer and intervene on our behalf

Provision Need - "Give us this day our daily bread," (Jesus: The Bread of Life)

Be in the will of God (prayer life, church, work habits, obedience in giving)

Believe it is God's will to prosper you

Be specific.

Be tenacious

"He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" Romans 8:32

Since God gave us Jesus, we can believe Him for everything we need.

Pardon Need - "And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us..."

Ask God to forgive you.

Forgive and release others

Set your will to forgive those who sinned against you

Forgiveness from God: I John 1:9 Forgiveness to Others: Mark 11:25-26

Forgiveness of Ourselves: I Timothy 1:15-16

Power Need - "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil..."

Put on the whole armor of God, the Lord Jesus Christ

Loins girt about with truth

Breastplate of righteousness

Feet shod with the preparation (readiness) of the gospel of peace

Shield of faith

Helmet of salvation

Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word (rhema) of God

Praying always in the Spirit

Pray a hedge of protection (the Lord is your refuge, your fortress, your God, in Him you will trust)

Because you have made the Lord your habitation

Because you have set your love upon Him

Because you have known His name.

You are never going to outgrow spiritual warfare, so you might as well learn how to fight. Jesus had to deal with satan, Paul had to deal with satan, we are going to have to deal with sa-

I Peter 5:8-9 – Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 9 Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

Resist the forces of darkness, that are trying to destroy you.

Partnership Need - "For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever."

Mark 11:23 "Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them. 24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

More saying than praying in this verse.

Make your faith declaration

Return to praise

Conclusion:

- God wants to meet every need you have.
- Needs are not automatically met. Must pray and release your faith.
