[Mat 1:5-7 NASB95] 5 Salmon was the father of Boaz by Rahab, Boaz was the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse. 6 Jesse was the father of David the king. David was the father of Solomon by Bathsheba who had been the wife of Uriah. 7 Solomon was the father of Rehoboam, Rehoboam the father of Abijah, and Abijah the father of Asa.

[2Sa 16:23 NASB95] 23 The advice of Ahithophel, which he gave in those days, [was] as if one inquired of the word of God; so was all the advice of Ahithophel [regarded] by both David and Absalom.

[1Ki 4:29 NASB95] 29 Now God gave Solomon wisdom and very great discernment and breadth of mind, like the sand that is on the seashore.

[1Ki 2:26 NASB95] 26 Then to Abiathar the priest the king said, "Go to Anathoth to your own field, for you deserve to die; but I will not put you to death at this time, because you carried the ark of the Lord GOD before my father David, and because you were afflicted in everything with which my father was afflicted."

[Jer 1:1 NASB95] 1 The words of Jeremiah the son of Hilkiah, of the priests who were in Anathoth in the land of Benjamin,

[Pro 26:2 NASB95] 2 Like a sparrow in [its] flitting, like a swallow in [its] flying, So a curse without cause does not alight.

[Mar 16:17 NASB95] 17 "These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues;

[Act 19:12 NASB95] 12 so that handkerchiefs or aprons were even carried from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out.

[Luk 10:17-20 NASB95] 17 The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name." 18 And He said to them, "I was watching Satan fall from heaven like lightning. 19 "Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you. 20 "Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven."

[Heb 6:1-2 NASB95] 1 Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of instruction about washings and laying on of hands, and the resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment.

[Luk 11:24-26 NASB95] 24 "When the unclean spirit goes out of a man, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, and not finding any, it says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' 25 "And when it comes, it finds it swept and put in order. 26 "Then it goes and takes [along] seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they go in and live there; and the last state of that man becomes worse than the first."
